## Methodology

The focus of this survey was to identify the public's opinion regarding cuts to an addiction treatment program at the North Bay Regional Health Centre.

This survey was conducted by Interactive Voice Response (IVR) on January $12^{\text {th }}$ and January $13^{\text {th }}, 2020$. Phone lists were created using our 2019 Canadian residents' White Pages database and Canadian cell phone database then randomized.

Only participants who completed this survey in its entirety have been included in this report. The results have been weighted against Statistics Canada 2016 Census data for age and gender in North Bay.

A total of 1005 participants have completed this survey. It has a margin of error of $\pm 3.053 \% 19$ times out of 20 .
