Central bargaining begins in September

Wages, benefits, vacations are key goals

Bargaining for the 50,000 CUPE members working in hospital and in LTC facilities with hospital beds, starts in mid-September.

Wages are the top priority in the bargaining. Improving benefits, premiums, bereavement leave and vacations are also key goals.



Study finds home washing machines do not kill viruses on uniforms and may actually make them stronger

A new study by DeMontfort University found that washing health care uniforms at home fails to kill significant bacteria and also encourages anti-microbial resistance - effectively helping some hospital acquired infections to evolve and become more resistant to antibiotics. The study suggests that on-site disinfection of uniforms in heavy duty washing machines and dryers is necessary. Read the study at:
